Programme Overview

The Award in Gender Based Violence Support for HR Professionals is an online accredited programme by the National Commission for Further and Higher Education, with 2 ECTS credits at EQF/MQF Level 5. The programme includes 2 Modules and each module will be delivered over a period of 2 weeks + 1 study week. The duration of the full programme is 6 weeks.

The Lead Tutor:
